Key Findings & Highlights

This NelsonHall vendor assessment analyzes MEHRWERK's process mining platform.

MEHRWERK ProcessMining (mpmX) is an API-first open product implemented on Qlik technologies. The company offers a generic template application that can be used for any process mining use case and delivers pre-built sets of analytic capabilities. In addition, it offers packaged business content apps—mpmX Process eXpert Apps—aimed at business users for specific process-system combinations, e.g., P2P Procurement on SAP. Content apps include a data extraction logic that is source system-specific and an event log generator and frontend that is specific to the business process being investigated.

Once process data has been loaded into mpmX, the platform features process analysis and monitoring through a set of customizable templates which aim to answer the typical questions related to processes across clients.

Organizations with a preexisting understanding of process mining and that are looking to commit to a single platform to support large-scale process reengineering efforts should take particular interest in this report on MEHRWERK.
