Key Findings & Highlights

Paychex (NASDAQ: PAYX), headquartered in NY, provides human capital management solutions, offering HR, payroll, retirement, and insurance services for small and mid-sized businesses primarily throughout the U.S. and in select countries of Northern Europe. Paychex has an employee base of ~16k employees and brings 50 years of industry experience. It offers a comprehensive suite of HR technology and HR and payroll services; each is enabled through its proprietary HCM technology, including:

- HR outsourcing services (HR, payroll, benefits)
- PEO services (co-employment model)
- Retirement planning services, managing 401(k) record keeping with ~100k plans and ~1m plan participants
- Insurance services, with ~\$2.6b in insurance premiums annually across ~205k customers, mainly related to health and benefits insurance and workers compensation insurance.

Paychex supports ~630k payroll clients, mainly SMEs (organizations with up to 1k employees), pays ~12m employees, and handles payments to every 12th private sector employee in the U.S. Its U.S. proprietary technology is Paychex Flex, which supports ~3m monthly users on a hybrid cloud infrastructure offering HR and payroll functionality.
