## Who Is This Vendor Assessment For?

NelsonHall's Cognitive IT Infrastructure Management Services Vendor Assessment for Atos is a comprehensive assessment of Atos' cognitive IT infrastructure management services offerings and capabilities designed for:

- Sourcing managers monitoring the capabilities of existing suppliers of IT services and identifying vendor suitability for cognitive IT infrastructure management services
- Vendor marketing, sales and business managers looking to benchmark themselves against their peers
- Financial analysts and investors specializing in cognitive IT infrastructure management services sector.

## Key Findings & Highlights

Atos' I&DM revenues for CY 2017 were ~€7.1bn, of which, NelsonHall estimates that cognitive IT infrastructure management services revenues were ~4% (~€300m).

Atos provides cognitive IT infrastructure services primarily through its Information & Data Management division (I&DM) through infrastructure services and Digital Workplace services. Also, cognitive and AI services are utilized through Atos Codex.

Within IT infrastructure management Atos is focusing on two key offerings:

- Incident remediation automation
- Cognitive data center.

And, across service desk on the following offerings:

- Atos Virtual Agent (AVA)
- End-use computing analytics (EUCA).
