Key Findings & Highlights

LTI Provides Digital Workplace Services as part of its Cloud and Infrastructure Services (CIS) division. In 2019 it introduced its Follow-me-IT (FIT), cloud-based platform, enabling traditional workplace environments to transform to a simplified digital workspace on cloud or hybrid model. It uses VDI, Microsoft EMS Suite (Intune & Azure AD), O365, and Windows 10. FIT will also utilize digital support services, including chatbots, AI, automation, smart service desk, and smart hands for deskside.

LTI's key services in support of digital workplace include professional services (consulting & transformation), and managed services. Its offerings underpinned by FIT, and include:

- Workplace Virtualization
- Identity, Access & Security
- **Application Services**
- **Unified Communication & Collaboration**
- Smart Service Desk & Field Support.
