Key Findings & Highlights

After the Dell Services acquisition, NTT DATA made an organizational change, removing P&L responsibility for its software testing practices, and putting the practices and communities of testers into a geography-based delivery structure with a vertical industry go-to-market approach. The purpose of this structure is drive client intimacy, while collaborating with the Global Testing TCoE on IP, common methodologies, and best practices.

The company is promoting the creation of IP and accelerators from a top-down approach, with budgets originating from the headquarters in Japan, and the different geographies, while encouraging bottom-up innovation.

Across its organization, NTT DATA estimates it has ~19k career testers globally.
